## 2018 – 2019 Participation Behavior Contract

1. All Renaissance Charter Schools at Pines Rules and Regulations also apply to the 21st Century at Pines (Pines Future Citizens) Program.
2. All participants and their parents are expected to know the rules and follow them.
3. Participants must be respectful to the staff and other participants. Staff must also be respectful of students.
4. Students are not allowed to leave school grounds and then return for an activity.
5. The schedule for Pines Future Citizens is from regular day dismissal until -5:45pm for K-8.
6. There will be no fighting, wrestling or bullying. Participants should always keep their hands to themselves.
7. The use of foul language and/or profanity is not acceptable.
8. Closed-Toed shoes must be worn at all times.
9. Participants may take off their belts and/or untuck their shirts during the afterschool program. Participants may change clothes only if their activity requires other attire. One example is athletic activities.
10. Participants are responsible for all of their belongings. Please keep up with your materials. Do not leave belongings or books in the classroom. The room may be locked when you come back later.
11. If there is a discipline problem, the Pines Future Citizens’ staff member will fill out a discipline referral. Any participants who are given a discipline referral will have to see Mrs. Clenace to remedy the situation. If the problem is severe or persistent, Mrs. Clenace, the Program Director will determine if further action is needed.
12. Most important, work hard and HAVE FUN!
